Guide for Continuing Professional Development (CPD)

Certified Asset Management Assessor (CAMA) Certificants are required to complete a minimum of fifty (50) hours of Continuing Professional Development (CPD) activities over their three-year certification period (as listed on the CAMA Certificate) to recertify for the following three years. These hours must come from two or more accepted CPD activities.

Accepted activities are detailed in the table on the second page of this document. Examples of how you combine activities to meet your required 50 hours of CPD:
